A Fee and Rate Categories

TUITION AND MANDATORY STUDENT FEES

In addition to regular academic year tuition, which includes the Capital Building fee, the Operating fee, and the Service and Activity fee, the Evergreen State College charges the following mandatory student fees:

CAB Renovation Fee: \$5.75 per credit (Max \$115.00)

Beginning Fall Quarter 2006, students enrolled at the Olympia campus are charged a mandatory fee on a per credit basis up to 20 credits. Fees collected help fund the approved College Activities Building (CAB) redesign project.

Clean Energy Fee: \$1.00 per credit (Max \$20.00)

The Evergreen State College students voted to have a mandatory Clean Energy fee assessed on a per credit basis up to 20 credits each quarter to offset the electricity that The Evergreen State College uses with the purchase of clean renewable energy.

Student Wellness Fee: \$184.00

This fee supports Student Wellness Services on campus and is not health insurance. It is a mandatory fee for students attending the Olympia campus who are registered for four (4) or more undergraduate or graduate credits. The Student Wellness Services office is closed during summer; no fees are charged during the summer quarters.

Late Night Shuttle Fee: \$5.00

A flat fee is charged to Olympia campus students per quarter (Fall, Winter and Spring only). Fees collected fund a late-night shuttle program to ensure that students have access to safe transportation after regular transit hours.

This fee is currently paused and will not be charged until further notice.

Transit Fee: \$2.50 per credit (Max \$30.00) -

All students registered at the Olympia campus are charged on a per credit basis up to a maximum of 12 credits. This program allows all students currently enrolled at the Olympia campus to ride Intercity Transit anywhere in Thurston County by showing their validated student ID card.

This fee is currently paused and will not be charged until further notice.

New Student Fee: New matriculated (degree seeking) undergraduate students enrolling at Evergreen for the first time are assessed a one-time fee which funds an enhanced student transition program designed to increase academic success. Students entering in the Fall quarter are charged \$300.00; those entering in the Winter or Spring quarter are charged \$170.00.

WashPig Fee: The Washington Public Interest Research Group is a nonprofit, politically unaligned corporation directed to students. Evergreen students have voted to support this organization via automatic billing. An \$8.00 charge is added on the student account each quarter along with tuition and fees. This fee can be waived by completing a waiver form.

GSU Fee: The Geoduck Student Union fee supports the annual operations of the student union. A \$2.25 charge per credit is added on the student account each quarter along with tuition and fees. This fee can be waived by completing a waiver form.

SPECIAL CLASS/COURSE FEES

Academic Student Fees are governed under RCW 28B.15.031. All class/course Fees must support credit-generating academic work in the program and are limited to:

- A fee that provides tools, equipment, or products that have a continuing value to the student (e.g. art material for a project retained by the student following the course);
- A fee that provides a pooled purchase of services the institution does not normally provide (e.g. a block of theater tickets at a group discount, where each student would otherwise be expected to buy an individual ticket or meals on a retreat or field trip);
- A fee that provides for overnight field trip expenses;
- A fee that provides for study abroad expenses;
- A fee that provides overhead expenses for managing the Academic Student Fee program;
- Fees cannot be used for consumable materials that are used by the entire program.

SERVICE FEES

A fee charged to students, staff and/or the public to cover the cost of providing goods or services. The rate of the fee is directly related to the cost of services or goods provided by Admission, Children's center, Copy center, Student Wellness Services center, Housing and Dining, Key Issues, Lab Store, Library, Media Loans, Parking and Transportation, Student Accounts and Cashiers and Others.
