

Requirements for your Travel Visit at Student Wellness Services

In order to provide the best service, we need this information **BEFORE** a travel consult visit can be scheduled:

Checklist:

- ___ Complete the Student Health Review Packet from the Office of International Programs and Services.
- Bring in all available immunization records.
- A <u>full</u> itinerary of where you will be traveling and for how long at each locale.
 - Any forms specific to your program. (Bring us a copy, or we can make a copy).
 - Contact your health insurance company and ask if they cover travel immunizations.

What to expect in the visit:

- Plan to be at the clinic for at least 1 hour.
- Individualized review of travel needs and recommendations for your health.
- Appropriate travel-related prescriptions.
- You may need oral and/or injectable vaccines. If not available at SWS, you may be referred.

Costs:

- We can bill insurance, or any charges incurred from your travel visit can be billed to your student account.
- Vaccines stocked at SWS do not incur any additional cost. However, if you are referred to another clinic/pharmacy for a vaccine which is not available at SWS, additional costs may apply.
- Prescription medication sent to a local pharmacy will incur additional cost.
- If your insurance has a specific form (reimbursement claim form) to help you get reimbursed for costs, please bring it with you to your appointment.
